Zoom Boom Ticket Marysville - Zoom Boom Training is designed to train operators on variable reach forklifts. The objectives of the training are to be able to impart an understanding of the physics of the machine, and to be able to outline the operator's tasks. This course adheres to North American safety standards for lift trucks. Zoom boom training and certification is accessible at the company's location or at our site, provided there are a few trainees. Certification received upon successfully finishing it is valid for three years.

The telehandler or telescopic handler is similar in several ways to a crane and a common forklift. This versatile equipment is made with a telescopic boom which can lift upwards and extend forward. Various attachments could be connected on the end of the boom, such as pallet forks, bucket, muck grab or lift table. It is popular in agriculture and industry settings.

The telehandler is a common used with fork attachments to be able to allow the transporting of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places which can't be reached by a common forklift. Telehandlers are capable of removing loads which are palletized from inside a trailer and putting them on places which are high like for example rooftops. For certain applications, they can be more efficient and practical than a crane.

The disadvantage of the telehandler is its instability when lifting loads which are heavier. When the boom extends with a load, the unit becomes more and more unsteady. Counterweights in the rear help, but do not solve the problem. The lifting capacity quickly decreases when the working radius increases. Various machinery come along with front outriggers that extend the lifting capacity while the machinery is stationary.
